BACK TO SCHOOL CHECKLIST

- 1. Return Authorization and Consent (blue), Developmental History (yellow), Health (white form or Pediatrician provided), Transportation Plan (purple) and First Aid/ Emergency Medical Care Consent (salmon) forms by the first day of school. The State requires that health forms be on file when your child starts school.
- 2. Provide an appropriate school bag for your child to bring to school every day. An open bag with handles works best. We suggest a reusable grocery bag because they are lightweight and large enough for school projects. Child's name should be in big letters on the outside.
- 3. Dress your child in play clothes. We do get messy with paint, water, mud, play dough, etc. Your child should feel free to explore!
- 4. Bring a complete change of clothes, in a bag labeled with your child's name, to be kept at school for emergencies. Your child will need extra pants, shirt, underwear, socks and shoes.
- 5. Label all sweaters, hats, boots, jackets and mittens. Please do not send your child to school with gloves. They are too difficult for a young child to put on by himself.
- 6. Check outer clothing to be sure it fits and is manageable by your child. Remember that we go outside every day. Being able to manage clothing is a great source of self-confidence for your child.
- 7. Take a snapshot of your child to bring to school on the first day.
- 8. Remember that your second tuition payment is due by September 15.
- 9. Make driving arrangements if you will carpool with another family. Please inform the Office in writing of these arrangements.
- 10. Answer your child's questions in a simple, straightforward manner, but do not talk about school too much. Your confident, positive approach to school will reassure your child that Erdman will be a safe and special place for him or her.
