CLASS ACTIVITIES

The Fours classes have been busy with a variety of number activities. They have created number lines, written books, counted out snacks and explored many different number manipulatives. All are currently learning their phone numbers and putting together individual class phone books. The 4 Day class has finished their spectacular vehicles and flying machines. See the display on the entry way bookcases! These classes will move on to their "All about Me" study - building houses, creating community maps, and talking about their families.

The Threes classes have explored colors and enjoyed the creative color snacks that parents have been kind enough to send in. We have only had a short time to explore our winter activities, but we know more winter weather will be coming our way!!

Now we are anticipating Valentine's Day! This is how we celebrate the day at Erdman:

On Thursday, 2/9 and Friday, 2/10 the Fours classes will visit the Scituate Post Office on First Parish Road to mail their handmade valentines to their families. Transportation will be by Totman school bus. Permission slips will be coming soon from your teachers.

On Monday, 2/13 or Tuesday, 2/14 each child will exchange cards (bought or homemade, as your child wishes) with classmates. Your child's name should be on the back of the cards. You do not need envelopes as each child will deliver a card to each classmate. Here is the number of children for your class:

4 day - 12, MTTH 4s - 12, MWF 4s - 14, MWF PM 3s - 12, MTTH 3s - 11, WF 3s - 12.

If you would like to provide a nut free snack on the day of your classes' party, please speak to your teachers. We'll spend lots of time during the next two weeks creating special Valentines for our families. This is a great opportunity to strengthen fine motor skills by tracing, cutting, lacing and gluing and to increase letter/sound awareness by discussing and writing letters while signing and addressing cards. Best of all we have lots of fun being very creative with paint, collage materials, stickers, markers and crayons.

WINTER WEATHER ALERT

We follow the Scituate Public Schools for school closings due to inclement weather. No school in Scituate means no school at Erdman. A one hour delay in Scituate means a one hour delay at Erdman. More than a one hour delay means no morning classes at Erdman and no Lunch Bunch, but afternoon classes will be held. It is your responsibility to access this information via the Scituate schools website @www.scituate.k12.ma.us. If Erdman must cancel for another reason you will be notified via email.

REMINDERS

Please dress your child warmly as the playground is cold, windy and wet. Layers are great. Hats, mittens (NOT GLOVES), snow pants and boots are necessary and should be in your child's school bag every day from now until spring! Extra dry socks are a necessity.
