CLASS ACTIVITIES

December was a busy month for everyone! The entry way bulletin board will give you a peek into holiday preparations. This month the cold weather will give us a chance to explore winter science and art. All classes will experiment with the properties of ice and snow at the sensory tables and watch the changes from solid to liquid and back again. (Physical Science#19 - Explore, describe and compare properties of liquids and solids). Threes and Fours will learn about winter birds and make several birdfeeders to help our feathered friends through the winter months. (Life Science #16 - Observe and describe seasonal changes in anima lives). Threes will work with colors along with science, art and language activities. Our young threes will explore shapes and incorporate them into creative activities, constructions and games.

The 4 Day class will create vehicles and flying machines while they investigate transportation and begin number themes. MWF and MTTH 4s will also work with shapes and numbers. They will create number books, number lines, explore many number manipulatives and enjoy counting out snacks at snack time. (Math#2 - Connect quantities of items and actions to numbers). They will also create winter scenes on their bulletin boards as they talk about seasonal changes. Lots of STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) activities this month!

WINTER WEATHER ALERT

We follow the Scituate Public Schools for school closings due to inclement weather. No school in Scituate means no school at Erdman. A one hour delay in Scituate means a one hour delay at Erdman. More than a one hour delay means no morning classes at Erdman and no Lunch Bunch, but afternoon classes will be held. It is your responsibility to access this information via the Scituate schools website @ www.scituate.k12.ma.us. If Erdman must cancel for another reason you will be notified via email.

REMINDERS

We want our children to be able to enjoy all the fun that outside winter play offers. We make snowmen, snow forts, tunnels, take hikes and go sledding. So...Please dress your child warmly as the playground is cold and windy. Layers are great. Hats, mittens (NOT GLOVES), snow pants and boots are necessary and should be in your child's school bag every day from now until spring! Extra dry socks are a necessity, too. Spending a few minutes helping your child learn to manage winter clothing increases self-confidence and decreases frustration.
