REMINDERS

Please dress your child warmly as the playground is still cold, windy and often wet. Layers are great. Hats, mittens (NOT GLOVES), snow pants and boots are necessary, especially when it is muddy, and should be in your child's school bag every day from now until spring! Slippers or shoes are required for indoor time. Extra dry socks are a necessity. Spending a few minutes helping your child learn to manage winter clothing increases self-confidence and decreases frustration.

We follow the Scituate Public Schools for closings due to inclement weather. No school in Scituate means no school at Erdman. A one hour delay means a one hour delay for Erdman. More than a one hour delay means no morning classes and no Lunch Bunch, but afternoon classes will begin at 1:00. It is your responsibility to access this information via www.scituate.k12.ma.us. If we must cancel for another reason you will be notified via email.

During the week of May 14 you will receive a year end Summary Report describing your child's progress and skills in the 7 developmental domains that are part of the Work Sampling System: Personal & Social Development, Language & Literacy, Mathematical Thinking, Scientific Thinking, Social Studies, the Arts and Physical Development. The summary report focuses on individual strengths and characteristics. You are welcome to arrange a conference with your teachers if you have questions but we do not schedule formal conferences at this time.
