OCTOBER CURRICULUM ACTIVITIES

Everyone has been busy getting to know friends and teachers names and becoming comfortable with the school day routine. It's a big job but everyone, including our youngest class, is doing well. We have had a happy, smooth start to the year!

This month we will explore:

- Science and nature observing the change of seasons, taking nature walks to find interesting items for our science tables and creative projects. Exploring apples, pumpkins and corn as we begin to learn about the farm to table process. We'll build with natural materials in our outdoor classroom area and experiment with gravity, balance, tension and design.
- Math counting, classifying and graphing apples by color, making apple counting books and watching apples change form solid to liquid when we make our delicious applesauce from scratch.
- Literacy Illustrating <u>Rainbow Fish</u>, listening to stories about friends, new school experiences and families, <u>The Family Book</u> by Todd Parr, beginning to write in our journals and use the alphabet stones.
- Creative Arts cooperative, friendship paintings, Reggio inspired self portraits, tearing and gluing collages and lots of time at the easel!
- Health and Safety Scituate Fire Dept. visit to learn about fire safety, see the truck and squirt the hose. Practice our monthly evacuation drills. Calm our bodies and minds with Yoga led by Laura Delong, Erdman mom and instructor at Studio 143.
- Social Skills –learning how to be a good friend by showing kindness and respect to everyone and understanding classroom expectations

The month will end with some very low key Halloween activities. Most will focus on pumpkins. Fours may bring a costume to school for our parade to other classrooms. Please make sure that the costume and the bag it comes in are both labeled with your child's name. Teachers will tell you the dates. Threes do not wear costumes but we will make masks for our parade. If you would like to provide a special treat (no candy and no nuts) for your child's class please speak to the teachers. **Please remember to read the message boards and check your child's bag every day.** <u>Along with</u> <u>these monthly newsletter, school wide emails are our major</u> <u>means of communicating with you.</u>

REMINDERS

FOR SAFETY'S SAKE....please do not park beside the orange cones. This area must be clear for children and parents entering and leaving the playground. Turn off your car's engine and ask a friend to watch siblings in the car if you don't want to bring them inside. If you need help with babies, please call the office and we can bring your child up or downstairs. Children should never be left alone in the car nor should they be allowed to run between the car and the playground at drop off or pick up time.

* Please remind your child that the church Memorial Garden is off limits to us both during the school day as well as after school.

* <u>Remember that the driveway is one way and you must exit</u> behind the church. Never go out the entrance. Thank you! *Please dress your child warmly as the playground can be cold and windy. Layers are great and hats and mittens will be necessary soon. Tuck them in your child's bag each day.

* Please arrive on time so that your child can start the day with his or her classmates. If you are delayed for pick up due to an emergency, call the office so that we can reassure your child that you are on the way.

* At both drop off and pickup please come INSIDE the playground fence and make verbal contact with your child's teacher before leaving. If you arrive before 9:00, please stay on the playground with your child until his/her teachers arrive. The Early Drop Off teacher is **not responsible** for your child at this time unless you sign them up.

*Now that Lunch Bunch has started, it is important that parents pick up their child at 11:30 and not stay on the playground at pick up time. Teachers have lots to do between classes and greatly appreciate your promptness! Thank you for your help!

* <u>Please Remember: The door will be locked each day</u> <u>at 9:15, opened at 11:15, locked at 1:15, opened at 3:15.</u> <u>The door will be locked during the 11:30 to 1:00 break. You</u> <u>must call the office @ 545-9309 to be let in at other times.</u> <u>This small security measure, along with adult awareness,</u> <u>has worked well to insure that no strangers enter the</u> <u>building.</u>

* We offer parents the opportunity to pay <u>once a month</u> for ALL PROGRAMS. At the beginning of each month families will receive an invoice due on the 15th for monthly tuition, all Extended Day and Lunch Bunch programs your child attended. All payment can be combined into one check. Don't worry we still offer the pay as you go option for Extended Day Options and Lunch Bunch if that works better for you. Karen is available in the office Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 to 1:30 to answer questions about billing, required forms and general Erdman information.
