JANUARY CLASS ACTIVITIES

<u>4 Day 4s</u> will be cruising into our transportation theme this month. Each child will create their own vehicle using a box, loose parts and their imagination. As we've seen in the past...the sky is the limit! We will also visit number recognition and number sense through hands-on activities and life examples like addresses and phone numbers. We'll also investigate how animals behave in winter. Through experiments, stories and observation of nature we will notice how some animals hibernate or migrate, while others adapt.

MTTH 4s will focus on winter and the importance of taking care of the wildlife that lives in our back yards. We'll read <u>The After</u> <u>Christmas Tree</u>, a story about re-purposing a holiday tree into a giving tree adorned with treats for birds and animals. We'll make a simple bird feeder and discuss what birds we might see at our feeders. Then we'll learn about shapes as we create artwork, play shape games, print with shapes, listen to stories and make a pizza in all shapes. We'll end the month focusing on numbers as we create number lines, make counting books, construct number grids, measure ingredients for baking and begin to learn our phone numbers.

MWF 4s will be busy exploring numbers, counting and pattern activities. We'll create counting books, practice sequence in songs and games and use patterns in art and building projects. We'll make bird feeders to help our feathered friends through winter and investigate winter through hands-on exploration. **MWF 3s** will be investigating primary colors and creating secondary colors through hands-on color mixing activities, colorful stories and enjoying colorful snacks. We're hoping for some snow so that we can enjoy wonderful winter fun-sledding on the hill, creating snowmen and building forts! MTTH 3s will be exploring the world of colors. We'll be mixing and creating with the primary colors. We'll begin with red and will glue a read collage and listen to the story, Red is Best. WF 3s will explore shapes. We'll learn what makes each shape unique and the way to identify each one. We'll use lots of manipulatives and art projects to engineer and create. We'll also taste delicious shapes: round blueberries, square cheese, triangle crackers and a round pizza cut into squares and triangles.

WINTER WEATHER ALERT

We follow the Scituate Public Schools for school closings due to inclement weather. No school in Scituate means NO school at Erdman. A <u>one hour</u> delay in Scituate means a <u>one hour</u> delay at Erdman. More than a one hour delay means no morning classes at Erdman and no Lunch Bunch, but afternoon classes will be held. We will try to notify you by email, however, to be certain, it is your responsibility to access this information via the Scituate schools website @

<u>www.scituate.k12.ma.us</u>. If Erdman must cancel for another reason you will be notified via email.

We will go outside to play every day that the temperature, including wind chill, is 20 degrees or warmer. The office uses the Weather Channel app to determine the Scituate "feels like" temperature.

REMINDERS

We want our children to be able to enjoy all the fun that outside winter play offers. We make snowmen, snow forts and tunnels, take hikes and go sledding. So...Please dress your child warmly as the playground is cold and windy. Layers are great. Hats, mittens (NOT GLOVES), snow pants and boots are necessary and should be in your child's school bag <u>every day</u> from now until spring! Extra dry socks are a necessity, too and slippers can be useful indoors instead of heavy boots. Spending a few minutes helping your child learn to manage winter clothing increases self-confidence and decreases frustration.
