CLASS ACTIVITIES

Erdman offers a play-based learning curriculum. Why? Research documents that play is the way children develop, build and reinforce knowledge about their world. It fosters social skills, enhances executive function, improves language and early literacy skills, supports math and science learning and provides health and physical benefits. Read more in the attached information and see below how our teachers use guided and free play experiences to support these skills.

The **Four Day 4's** will be all about ME! We will create models of our own homes, thinking about what we see right in our own yards. Reinforcing our letters and numbers we will continue to learn our phone numbers and addresses. We will trace our bodies and paint them thinking about our features – skin color, eye color, hair color.

MWF 4's will be learning all about community and neighborhood in the month of March. We will start by creating an **Erdman Community** bulletin board for the downstairs entry way – coming soon! We will build on our knowledge of community by visiting and observing neighboring buildings – Lawson Tower, the library and senior housing and finish by creating our own house models.

MTTH 4's are continuing to concentrate on what makes us alike and different, special and unique. We will create self portraits, mix colors as we print our hands and feet, learn our initials and create a "family tree". As we talk about the similarities and differences in our families we'll support that conversation with a family graph and a picture of families on paper. It will be a busy month!

MWF 3s will bring March in with a ROAR as we explore all things dinosaur! We'll share ideas and thoughts about what they know and what they want to know; things like extinction, habitats and volcanoes. We'll finish the month like lambs as we move on to literacy rich nursery rhymes and fairy tales.

MTTH 3'S will learn about some of our favorite nursery rhymes this month. Singing, rhyming and acting our nursery rhymes develops phonological awareness which is an important pre-reading skill and teaches children how language works. Acting our stories makes children feel confident, reinforces cooperation and is so much fun!

WF 3's will be exploring the colors in our world. We'll create with art materials, engineer with manipulatives, solve science problems and investigate and enjoy different snacks all based around the color of the day.

All classes will be watching the Explorers gather sap for maple syrup and create egg trees. A spring tradition at Erdman! We need your help! **Please send in as many eggshells as you can between March 25 - o 29.** White is ideal but brown will work, too.

Please break them in half, wash with soap and warm water and soak in a mild bleach solution for a few minute. Each child uses about 6 to 8 halves. Thank you so much. You'll love the addition to your spring décor!

REMINDERS

Our playground is still cold, windy and often wet. Please make sure your child has hats, mittens (NOT GLOVES), snow pants and boots! All are necessary, *especially when it is muddy*, and should be in your child's school bag <u>every day</u> from now until spring! Slippers or shoes are required for indoor time. Extra dry socks are a necessity. Please return any that have gone home with your child. Thank you!

- A one hour delay means a one hour delay for

Erdman. Early drop off at 9:30. Classes begin at 10:00.A delay greater than one hour means no morning

classes and no Lunch Bunch. Afternoon classes will begin at 1:00.

• Early dismissal in the public schools means Erdman closes after Lunch Bunch at 1:00.
